Community Forums on *Part 2 and the HIE* Announced

Health Current joined some of the key presenters at the inaugural Phoenix Children's Care Network (PCCN) Annual Update meeting on Thursday May 17, 2018. Many of the approximately 35 practices in attendance are not only Health Current participants but also



participants in the Practice Innovation Institute (Pi Institute or Pi²), a collaboration of Health Current, Mercy Care Plan and Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care. The meeting featured a review of PCCN's 2018 priorities and also included the distribution of

over \$2 million in shared savings checks to the participating practices.

Stacey Rochman, Health Current Director of TCPI and Special Projects, presented in a breakout session that featured the benefits of Health Current participation and how information from Health Current can assist in improving the care of patients. In addition, representatives from the Pi Institute also presented in a breakout session that focused on the next transformation steps to prepare practices for value-based, alternative payment arrangements. The PCCN Update meeting was an excellent opportunity to reach some of the key clinicians that rely on Health Current services to transform their practices, according to Rochman. "This was a great opportunity to bring everyone together to work on mutual goals," she said.
