

# New DAP for Arizona Crisis Capacity Data Exchange

## A New Data Sharing Incentive Program for Crisis Service Providers

Health Current, a Contexture organization, is pleased to introduce the new AHCCCS Differential Adjusted Payment (DAP) program to encourage AHCCCS contracted crisis service providers to share bed and observation capacity data with the Arizona health information exchange (HIE).

The goal of the program is to secure the necessary data in the HIE to better serve the needs of patients across Arizona experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

The three DAP program milestones are:

- Submit a DAP letter of intent (LOI) by May 1, 2022
- Sign an HIE participation agreement by July 1, 2022
- Submit a Statement of Work (SOW) to transmit real-time observation and stabilization capacity data by Nov. 1, 2022

HIE participants who meet the three milestones receive a 3% increase on their AHCCCS payments beginning October 1, 2022.

### Eligible Crisis Provider Types

The following crisis service providers contracted with AHCCCS are eligible to participate:

- Subacute facilities (1-16 beds), provider type B5
- Subacute facilities (17+ beds), provider type B6
- Crisis services provider, provider type B7
