COVID-19 Immunization Data Available in the HIE

[COVID-19 Immunization Data](#) is available from Health Current. Arizona HIE portal users can access the data today – simply log in to the portal to see if a patient your organization serves has received the COVID-19 vaccine. This status will be reflected in the immunization section of portal patient record. Immunization data shared by HIEs offers several benefits:

- Provides rapid access to important patient health information at the point of care;
- Helps speed the collection of vaccine data and allows the healthcare community to assemble a clearer picture of at-risk populations;
- Proven effective in the fight against seasonal flu, shingles, and other infectious diseases; and
- Reduces the amount of paperwork involved in immunization tracking and frees clinical staff to pursue other patient care activities.

Deadlines to migrate to the new HIE 3.0 platform:



- Participants who receive **HIE Alerts** must migrate by **Monday, Aug. 30, 2021**.
- Participants who access the **HIE Portal** must migrate by **Thursday, Sep. 30, 2021**.
- **IMPORTANT:** The old Mirth platform will be sunset and unavailable after the above dates.
