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### SDOH System Roadshow Information Series Concludes

#### *Materials From Sessions Available on Health Current Website*

Health Current recently wrapped up its SDOH Roadshow series of community education events created to provide a preview of the new social determinants of health (SDOH) referral system we are working to develop to address SDOH needs in Arizona.



Over the last two months, we hosted 13 informational sessions, including two in-depth demonstrations of the SDOH closed loop referral system to further explore the functionality this technology platform provides, as well as two sessions that focused specifically on how the platform will help community-based organizations (CBOs) better support the people they serve.

We are proud to report that over 1,000 participants attended the various SDOH Roadshow sessions to learn more about the features this new system offers.
