Deadline Reminder: DAP Hospital Participants Must Submit a Signed Quality SOW by Nov. 1



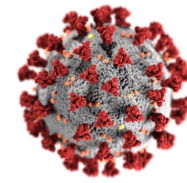
The deadline is approaching for Phase 1 and Phase 2 hospital/inpatient facility participants in the CYE 2021 Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) Differential Adjusted Payment (DAP) program to sign and return the CYE 2021 Quality Scope of Work (SOW).

To verify your intent to participate in the CYE 2021 program, please review the SOW

you received from Health Current the week of October 15th, sign the document, and return it to your designated Health Current Account Manager by **November 1, 2020**.
